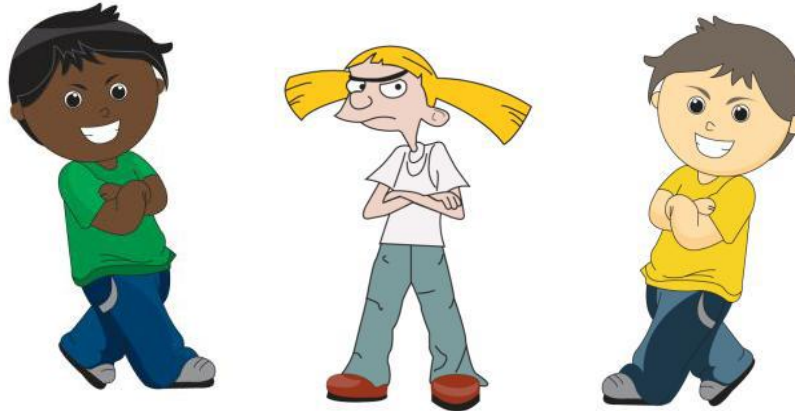


# Happy Kids Don't Bully



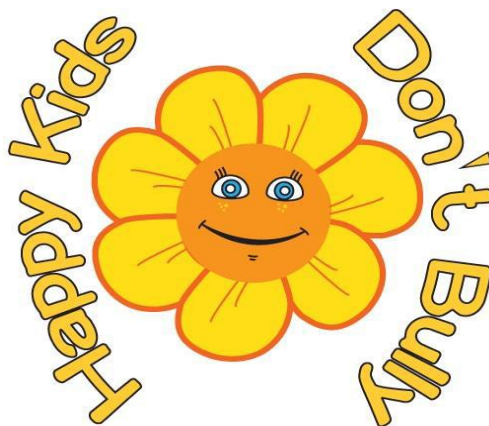
**Bullying is not just about the target**

## How will it benefit your school?

Your pupils will achieve better results and be happier children free from the fear of bullying.

Your school will spend more time teaching and less time dealing with bullying issues saving you £££'s in lost teaching hours.

Your parents and governors will see you taking bullying seriously and actively doing something to stop it.

You will be seen in your community as a school who takes bullying very seriously.

Stress levels amongst the teaching and support staff will reduce when they have fewer confrontational issues to deal with.

## Happy Kids Don't Bully is an entire school programme

There are a variety of different workshops to choose from and they can be used on a mix and match basis:

- Assembly Workshops – up to 100 children – 1 hour [up to 3 per day]
- Pupil Workshops – 1 class – Ages 4 – 18 – 1 hour [up to 4 per day]
- Parental Workshop – 1½ hours
- Teacher Workshop – how to run a Happy Kids Don't Bully Workshop - full day
- Midday supervisor Workshop - How to prevent Bullying in the Playground – half day

Accompanying materials:

- Teachers, Midday Supervisor and Pupil Workbooks
- Pre and Post event suggested activities for pupils
- Happy Kids Don't Bully Trophies
- Bully Survival Kits containing Advice, Sticker and Wristband or Balloon
