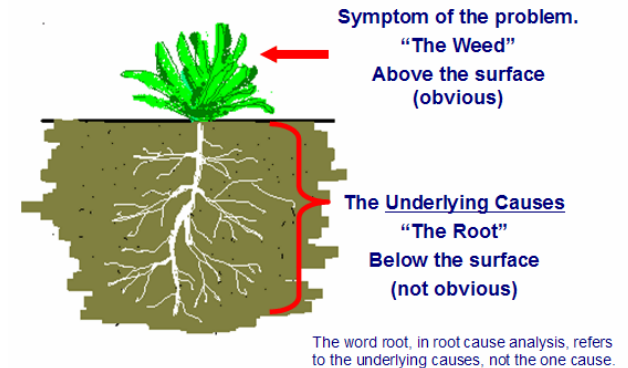
Happy Kids Don't Bully – the missing link

Root Cause Analysis Basics

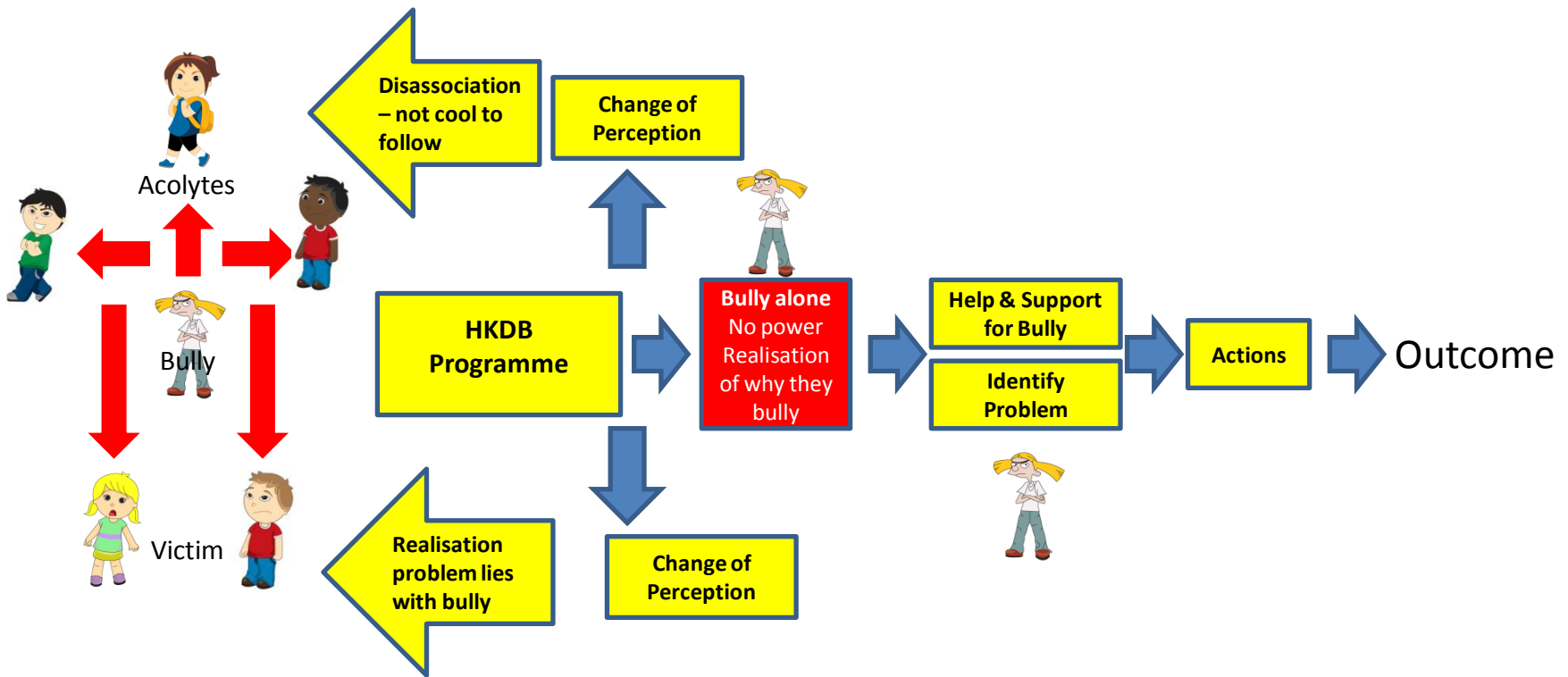


The missing link is:

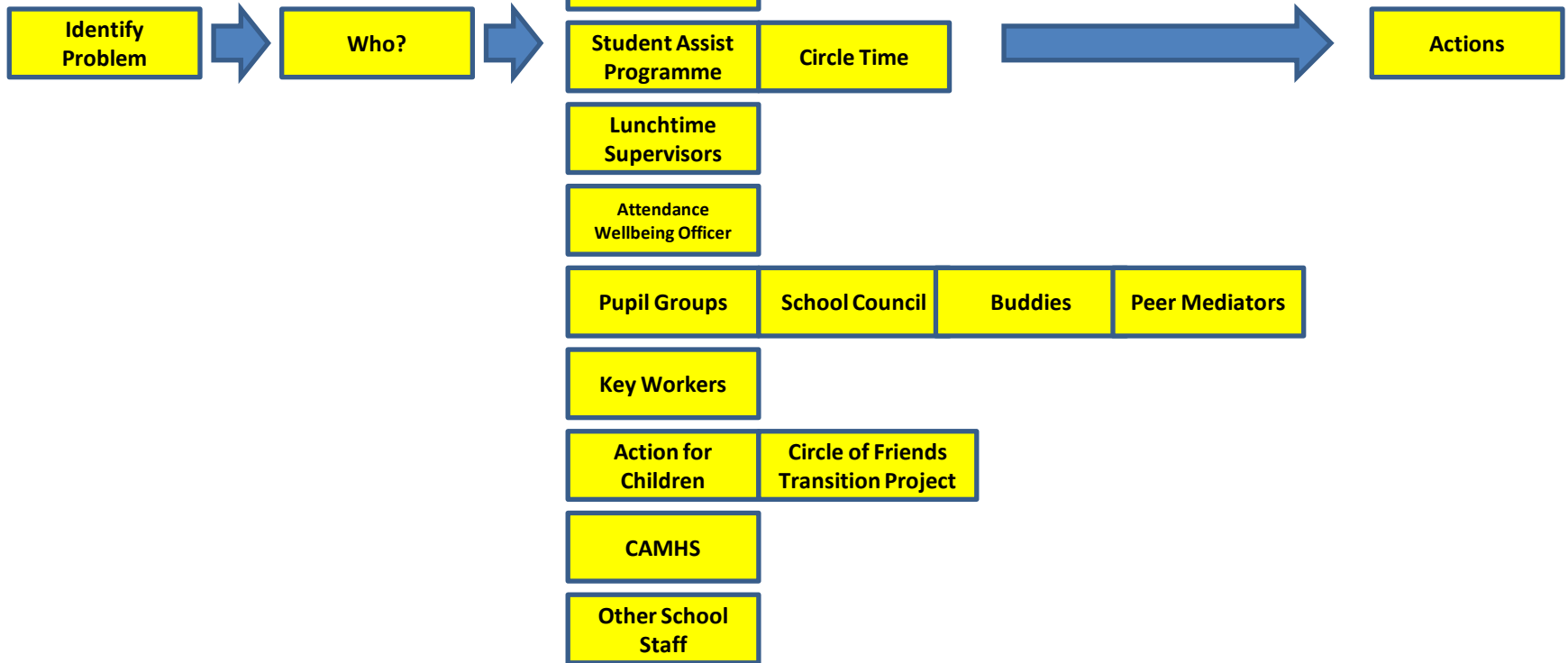
Why does the bully bully? Which is why  was created
